Ames Water Treatment Plant: The Ames Water Treatment Plant provides water for 18,000 homes and businesses. Come see how the new \$50 million facility is providing crisp, safe, and delicious water to Ames residents.

Prairie Moon Winery: Prairie Moon Winery and Vineyards started in 2000 when Steven Nissen planted the first vines of what is now a 13-acre vineyard. They may not be as famous as a Merlot, Chardonnay, or Cabernet but grapes from Iowa can make good wines and provide more diversity in our agricultural systems.

Scholarships & Dinner: Scholarships will be presented to ASABE students. A BBQ dinner is being catered by Ames' newest BBQ attraction Jethro's.
