

INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

All authors and/or presenters must register for the conference by **APRIL 13, 2007.**

Authors/Presenters who do not register for the conference by the deadline will:

- not be given time after the registration deadline to make the presentation.
- papers will be removed from the conference proceedings
- papers will be removed from the ASABE Online Technical Library
- papers will not be printed or acknowledged by ASABE in on-site program

INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS:

1. The published CD ROM of the conference symposium papers will be distributed at the conference. All papers presented at the meeting will be available in the ASABE Technical Library.
2. Instructions for preparing manuscripts in electronic format will be issued with acceptance notification. Authors will be asked to provide a draft to be reviewed for gross errors and overall completeness and then return for corrections. The review is not to be considered a technical peer review for journal publication purposes.
3. After acceptance of the paper the author will be required to provide the paper in electronic format to the Proceedings Chair. You'll find an MS Word template and author guide instructions on the web at:

The template will automatically format the document and help speed processing time at Headquarters. At a minimum, it would be helpful if you would fill in the table at the beginning of the template and complete the cover page.

Authors are encouraged to submit their papers for possible publication in a peer-reviewed journal such as *Transactions of the ASABE*, *Applied Engineering in Agriculture* and *Journal of Agricultural Safety and Health*. For further information, contact the ASABE Publications Department.

4. Eight single-spaced pages is the limit for all papers.
5. CONFERENCE REGISTRATION FEE WILL BE DUE WITH FINAL PAPER SUBMISSION BY APRIL 13, 2007. Funding is not available from the conference for prepresenter participation. Presenters will be required to pay all their costs including the meeting registration fee. ASABE will give all accepted presenters the opportunity to register at the ASABE member rates.
6. The official language of the symposium will be English.
7. A visa and passport may be required of international presenters. Requests for visa letters should be made 4 to 6 months prior to the scheduled conference date. For more information regarding visas visit
