An additional opportunity is available to present a power point presentation of your research on Tuesday, February 14 at 2:30pm. Limited time slots are available so it is on a first come, first service basis.

The poster session will be held on Monday, February 13, from 3:30pm to 5:00pm, in conjunction with an industry

exhibition. The format of this session will allow the presenters to have direct one-on-one interaction with their audience for maximum information exchange. Traditional ASABE papers are welcome, but not required.

Each poster presenter will be provided with a 8-foot wide by 4-foot deep poster board. Poster boards will be of neutral color. You can affix your presentation by push pins or thumb tacks.
