The History of the Water Reclamation District and the Development and Construction of the Tunnel and Reservoir Plan (TARP) System - Speaker Adam Gronski

Adam Gronski will be speaking on the history of the Water Reclamation District and the development and construction of the Tunnel and Reservoir Plan (TARP) system. Mr. Gronski is a Senior Civil Engineer and has been with the Water Reclamation District since 1994. He has a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of Illinois in Urbana/Champaign and a Professional Masters in Environmental Engineering from the Illinois Institute of Technology. He has been working in the Tunnel and Reservoir Plan Unit since 2002 and oversees the Post-Award Design Engineering for the Little Calumet Deep Tunnel Leg and also multiple projects associated with the McCook Reservoir.

Infrastructure Overview of the Department of Water Management for the City of Chicago – Speaker Mark O'Malley

Mark O'Malley, *Engineer of Water Pumping* for the City of Chicago, will provide an overview of Chicago's water management infrastructure, which includes the water filtration plant located next to Navy Pier.
