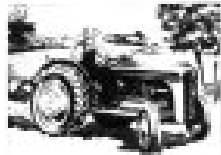

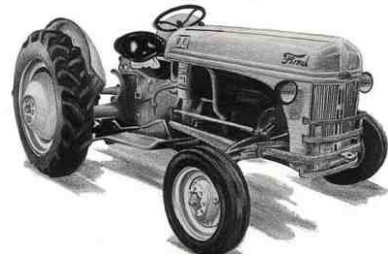

Harold Brock began his career at Ford Motor Co. in 1929 at the age of 15 in the Ford Trade and Apprentice School, working under the guidance of Henry Ford. He worked as an engineer in the automotive division and then joined the tractor division. He went on to become the chief engineer of tractor engineering from 1939-1959 and led the team that developed the Ford N series tractors. During his tenure at Ford he personally worked with Henry Ford, Edsel Ford, and Henry Ford II. While at Ford, Mr. Brock also had the opportunity to meet and work with historical figures such as Thomas Edison and George Washington Carver.



Mr. Brock left Ford in 1959 to serve as director of product engineering at John Deere Waterloo Works to develop Deere's "New Generation" tractors, which replaced the 2 cylinder models. Brock became Deere's first worldwide director of tractor design in 1962.

Mr. Brock has served as a president of SAE and is a fellow of both SAE and ASABE. He has also authored and co-authored several books including *The Big Book of Ford Tractors*, *The Big Book of John Deere Tractors*, and *The Fords in My Past*.
